Schedule of fees for students with a permanent address abroad¹

2023/24 school year: valid from 1 August 2023 until 31 July 2024

Louisenlund is a non-profit foundation. Apart from a partial subsidy from the state of Schleswig-Holstein (which under the Schleswig-Holstein Act on Schools applies only to children domiciled in the state of Schleswig-Holstein who attend grammar schools and is applied solely to tuition costs), Stiftung Louisenlund must cover all of its running costs from payments received from the parents. The parental contribution is set by Stiftung Louisenlund as an annual fee payable per school year. The payment obligation for a school year arises on 1 August and expires on July 31 of the following calendar year, regardless of the commencement of the summer holidays or the date of the graduation or IB examinations.

The agreed parental contribution covers the cost of boarding, all meals, tuition, participation in services and guilds, health care for minor illnesses and insurance for students covering accidents, fire and burglary. Participation in some guilds is subject to payment of an additional fee: tennis (hall rental in winter), model construction, etc.

All personal expenses of the students such as sportswear, house sweaters, textbooks, pocket money, travel expenses, medical treatment as well as outlays made by the school for individual lessons (music lessons, remedial lessons, training in special sports), for excursions and recreational sports trips, theatre visits and the like are charged separately.

* Upper school contribution: If the student is enrolled in Year 10 or higher, the monthly parental contribution increases by 260 euros per month until the completion of the school-leaving examinations.

2. Admission fee (non-recurring): Euro 1.900

3. Security deposit payable upon admission: Euro 10.000

4. Contribution to the Parent Council's account: Euro 5 per year

5. Advance payment towards service charges: Euro 5.000 per year

6. School year in Germany: The school year begins on 1 August and ends on 31 July of the following calendar year. A school semester runs from 1 August to 31 January and from 1 February to 31 July of each year.

¹ A student with a permanent address abroad is any student whose parents/guardians have their habitual residence or abode in another country.
