## Scale of fees for day students

Louisenlund is a charitable foundation. Aside from a partial grant from the state towards the sole tuition costs (received only for local children attending a grammar school in accordance with the Schleswig-Holstein School Act), Louisenlund must cover all of its operational expenses from payments received from the parents. The fees paid by the parents are determined by the Louisenlund Foundation Board as an annual amount for one school year. Fees for the school year are to be paid monthly from 1 August until 31 July of the following calendar year regardless of the date of the summer holidays or the school terminating examinations (Abitur or IB).

The fees include the cost of lunch and snacks, tuition, participation in the services and guilds, health care in the event of minor ailments as well as insurance coverage for students against accident, fire and burglary. Some of the guilds require additional payments: tennis (hall rental in winter), riding (horse rental) etc.

All personal expenses for students are invoiced separately, e.g. school pullover, text books, telephone calls, travel expenses, medical treatment and any outlays incurred by the school for private activities (music lessons, remedial teaching, special sports training), excursions and leisure activities, visits to the theatre and the like.

### 2. Admisson fee: (payable once only): Euro 515

### 3. Upper school fees: upon enrollment to upper school, there is a monthly increase of Euro 250 to tuition for the total period of upper school.

### 4. Deposit upon admission:

If the fees are paid by direct bank debt (normal case): Euro 2.000

Other forms of payment (available only on request): Euro 3.000

### 5. Contribution to parent committee: Euro 5 per year

### 6. School year in Germany: The school year commences on 1 August and ends on 31 July of the following calendar year. The two semesters are from 1 August until 31 January and from 1 February until 31 July of each year.
